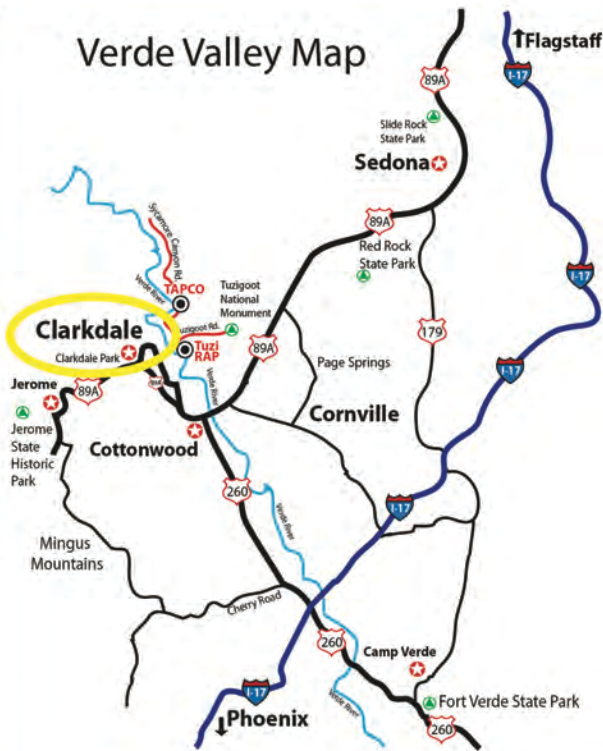


Verde Valley Map

Founded in 1912 and incorporated in 1957, Clarkdale, Arizona was a company town and the first, master-planned community in Arizona, providing housing and amenities for the families and employees of the local copper smelter.

As one of the larger historic districts in Arizona, Clarkdale's Historic District features **381** contributing buildings within the original town site. As one lovely example of these, the Clark Memorial Clubhouse is available for community rentals. In addition, three museums await visitors chock full of interesting memorabilia from the Town's mining past: the Arizona Copper Art Museum, the Clarkdale Historical Society and Museum, and the John Bell Museum. Also home to Tuzigoot National Monument featuring a fascinating interpretive center, Clarkdale entices with glimpses into her colorful past.
